John 5:22-30

22 For the Father judges no one, but has committed all judgment to the Son, 23 that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. Romans For the judgment which came from one offense resulted in 5:16 condemnation, but the free gift which came from many offenses resulted in justification. so that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of 1 our Lord Jesus Christ, Corinthians 1:7 10 Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus 1 Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions Corinthians among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind 1:10-12 and in the same judgment. 11 For it has been declared to me concerning you, my brethren, by those of Chloe's household, that there are contentions among you. 12 Now I say this, that each of you says, "I am of Paul," or "I am of Apollos," or "I am of Cephas," or "I am of Christ." Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this 1 age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? Corinthians 1:20 for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions 1 among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men? Corinthians 3:3 Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who 1 will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the Corinthians counsels of the hearts. Then each one's praise will come from God. 4:5 For who makes you differ from another? And what do you have that you 1 did not receive? Now if you did indeed receive it, why do you boast as if Corinthians

1 Corinthians 7:17 But as God has distributed to each one, as the Lord has called each one, so let him walk. And so I ordain in all the churches.

1 Corinthians 10:14–22 14 Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry. 15 I speak as to wise men; judge for yourselves what I say. 16 The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? 17 For we, though many, are one bread and one body; for we all partake of that one bread. 18 Observe Israel after the flesh: Are not those who eat of the sacrifices partakers of the altar? 19 What am I saying then? That an idol is anything, or what is offered to idols is anything? 20 Rather, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice they sacrifice to demons and not to God, and I do not want you to have fellowship with demons. 21 You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons; you cannot partake of the Lord's table and of the table of demons. 22 Or do we provoke the Lord to jealousy? Are we stronger than He?

1 Corinthians 10:32 Give no offense, either to the Jews or to the Greeks or to the church of God,

1 Corinthians 11:2 Now I praise you, brethren, that you remember me in all things and keep the traditions just as I delivered *them* to you.

1 Corinthians 11:17 Now in giving these instructions I do not praise *you*, since you come together not for the better but for the worse.

1 Corinthians 11:21–25

21 For in eating, each one takes his own supper ahead of *others*; and one is hungry and another is drunk. 22 What! Do you not have houses to eat and drink in? Or do you despise the church of God and shame those who have nothing? What shall I say to you? Shall I praise you in this? I do not praise *you*. 23 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the *same* night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke *it* and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 25 In the same manner *He* also *took* the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me."

1 Corinthians 15:23	But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming.
1 Corinthians 16:1	Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given orders to the churches of Galatia, so you must do also:

1 Timothy	1 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart

Hebrews

5 And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: "My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, Nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him; 6 For whom the LORD loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives." 7 If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? 8 But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons. 9 Furthermore, we have had human fathers who corrected us, and we paid them respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live? 10 For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He for our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness.

- 2 Peter 2:1— 1 But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction. 2 And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed.
- 2 Peter 2:13 and will receive the wages of unrighteousness, as those who count it pleasure to carouse in the daytime. They are spots and blemishes, carousing in their own deceptions while they feast with you,
