49.25 κομάω: to wear long hair as part of one's attire—'to have long hair, to appear with long hair, to wear long hair.' γυνὴ δὲ ἐὰν κομᾷ δόξα αὐτῇ ἐστίν 'if a woman wears long hair, it is a pride for her' [1 Cor 11:15](#). In a number of languages it may be necessary to translate κομάω as 'to let one's hair grow long' or 'not to cut one's hair.'

2863. κομάω komáō; contracted *komō*, fut. *komēsō*, from *kómē* ([2864](#)), hair. To have long hair ([1 Cor. 11:14, 15](#)). Paul teaches that a woman's hair ought to be different from a man's, and that a woman's hair is equivalent to a *peribólaion* ([4018](#)), something that is wrapped around, a veil or mantle. From the context, it seems that the woman's hair ought to be distinct from a man's hair, not only in length, but also in ornamentation.
